

# Massachusetts Field Archery Association Scholarship Program

## Purpose:

Provide a \$500 scholarship to deserving area youth that are active in archery, active in supporting the community and show an eagerness to achieve through knowledge by intending to pursue post-high school courses of study at either a college/university or other post-secondary educational institutions.

1. Deadline for scholarship application is November 30<sup>th</sup> of the current academic year.
2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements
3. Refer to application process below for a list of supporting documents required
4. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will NOT be considered
5. Scholarship winner to be chosen by the Board of Directors and Club Representatives at the December MFAA Meeting. The Awardee(s) to be notified prior to the start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester in January.

## Criteria:

Students must be accepted into a post-secondary educational institution and be an active member of the MFAA/NFAA.

Applicant will need to submit the following items:

1. Completed Application form: (if handwritten, please print legibly.) \*\*\*See #4 in Purpose.
2. Applicant will need 2 letters of recommendations, one from choice of high school teacher, administrator or counselor, employer or someone from which the applicant has done community service. The other from an unrelated individual with significant knowledge of the applicant's experience and involvement with the Sport of Archery.
3. Applicant will forward a copy of most recent high school and/or college/university transcript with cumulative grade point average.
4. Applicant will submit a personal Essay on how their participation in archery has influenced their lives or career goals and in which archery activities they have participated in for the last year. Also, please include an archery picture of yourself (to be posted on the MFAA website if the awardee is chosen).

**Renewal Process:** this scholarship is not renewable.
